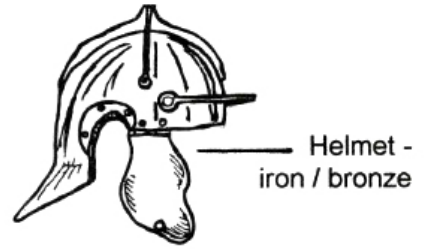
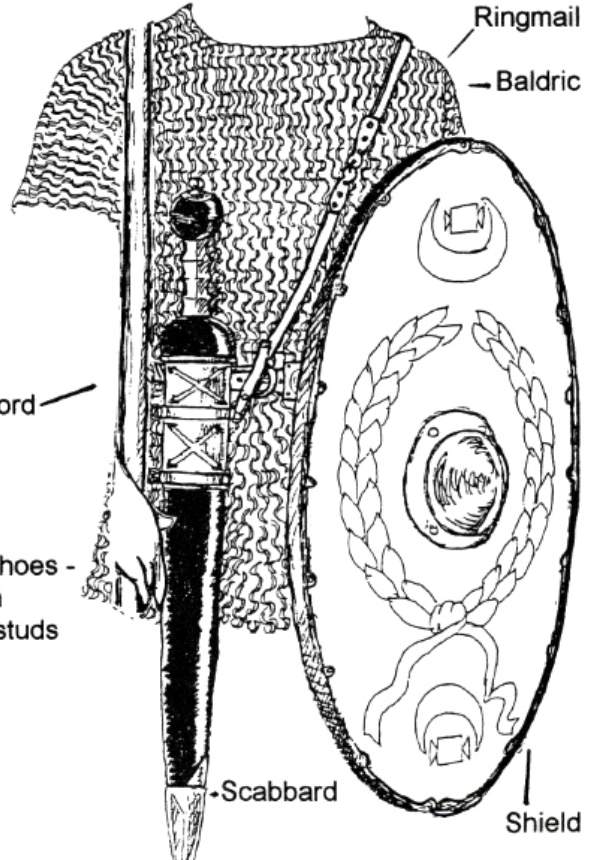
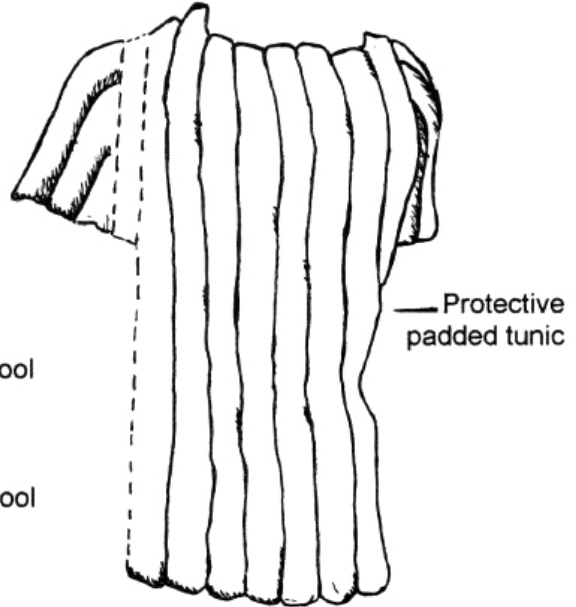
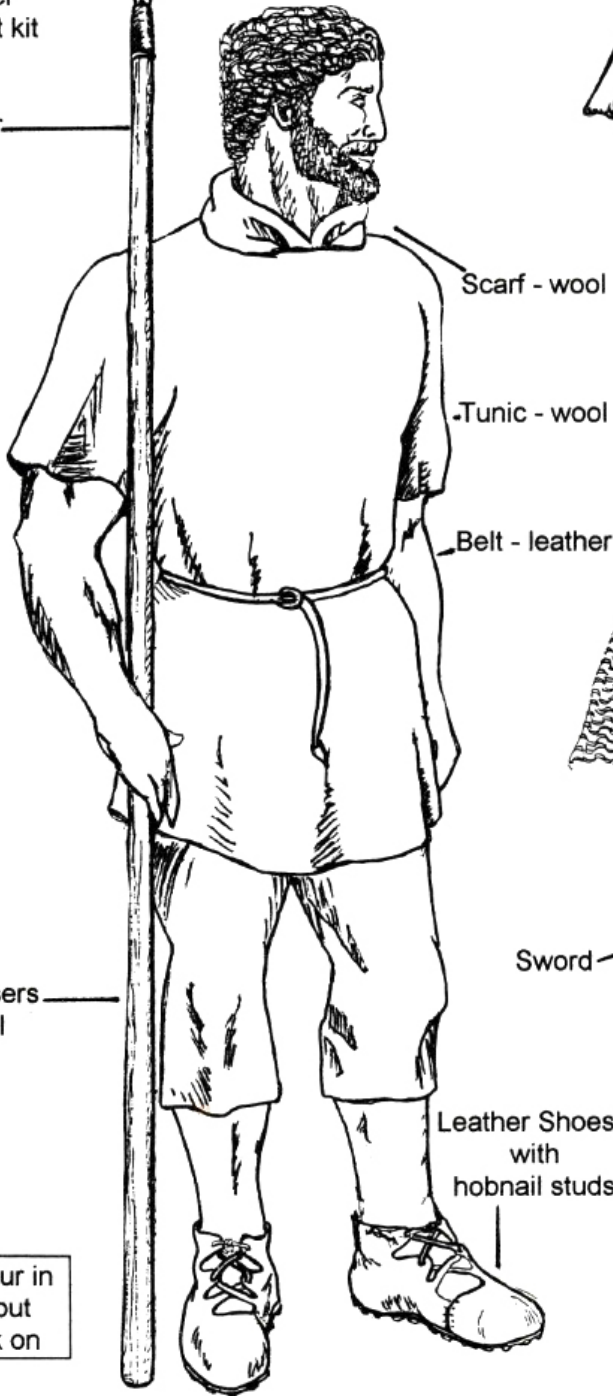


**A Segedunum Soldier to prepare for action!

Auxiliary Soldier

The soldiers who lived at Segedunum Roman Fort were Auxiliary soldiers.

'Auxilia' means help and the Auxiliary soldiers assisted the Legionary soldiers by providing extra manpower and in particular specialised fighting techniques.

They were made up of the infantry (foot soldiers) and cavalry (horse) units.

All you need to do is:

3. Stick on all his uniform
