

Pop-up Fort

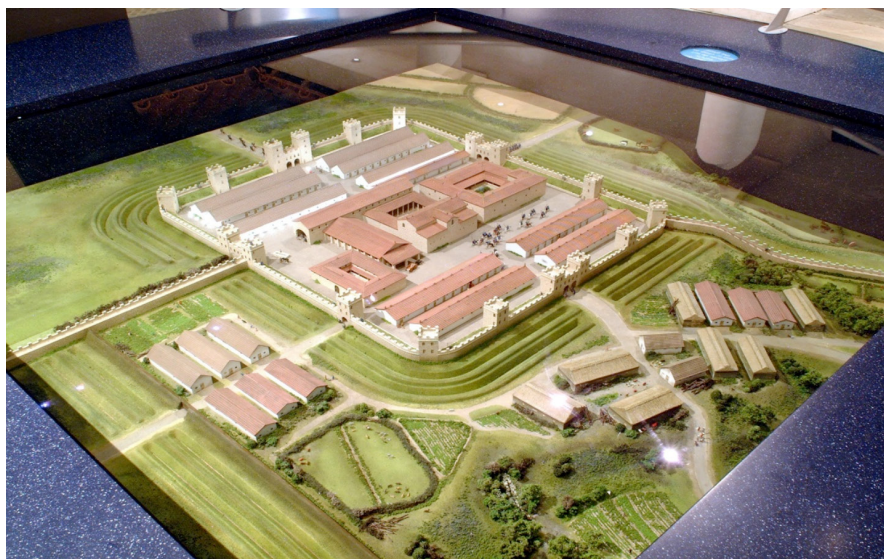
Segedunum Roman Fort lay at the eastern end of Hadrian's Wall. The fort was occupied for around 300 years by a cohort of 480 infantry and 120 cavalry soldiers.

Why not have a go at creating your very own pop-up Segedunum Roman fort scene?

All you need to do is:

1. Colour in and cut out the template on the other side
2. Fold tabs and stick your template onto some card

You could also have a go at creating your own 3D version of the fort (using our fort from inside the Roman Gallery as inspiration).
