

<b>Workshop : Move Ahead in History</b>		
<b>National Curriculum Links</b>		
KS1 and KS2 History - develop chronological understanding; the changes in Britain from Stone Age to Iron Age; the Roman Empire and its impact; Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and the Viking, and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor.		
<b>Learning objectives</b>	<b>Session structure</b>	<b>Assessment for learning</b>
<b>To develop chronological understanding of key events and time periods in British history from the Stone Age to the Normans</b>	<p><b>Introduction</b></p> <p>Briefly explain the concept of a timeline and explain to children what will happen in this activity i.e. if children answer questions correctly they can come up and play the role of one of the people on the timeline.</p> <p><b>Session activities</b></p> <p>Children will listen to hear information about the different time periods from the Paleolithic Age to the time of the Normans. They will answer questions as we go and different children will be asked to come up and play the part of people from these different time periods.</p> <p><b>Plenary</b></p> <p>Check that children understand the chronological order of the different time periods</p>	<p>Children will be able to answer questions about the different time periods and will develop their chronological understanding of key events and time periods in British History from the Stone Age to the Normans.</p> <p>Children will have opportunities to respond and give feedback throughout the session.</p>
